HALO Regional Event - (Level C) FINAL DETAILS

Location & **Parking**

Grid Reference TA129037 (Pelham's Pillar), 3km NE of Caistor, Lincolnshire.

At 'Caistor Top' on the A46, follow the A1173 for 1km approx., bear left – look for signs to turn right into the wood via the game-keeper's cottage, (Postcode: LN76RP).

CONTINUE North TOWARDS Pelham's Pillar – park neatly please beside the track.

Toilets in the car parking area.

Terrain

An area of mixed woodland with long valleys, some steep slopes, a large open area towards the centre and very wide rides throughout the woods. There is a variety of contour detail and good runnability. Some tall undergrowth may be encountered. Significant undergrowth is shown.

Map

1:10000, 5m contours. Up-dated 2016. Shorter courses 1:5000 Maps A3 will be printed on recyclable waterproof paper.

Entries

From 10am please register using your SI Card at 'The HALO Tent' in the parking area off the forest track. Those with **new 'dibbers'** will be asked to complete a reg. form.

Electronic SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30.

To be quite sure of a map with your chosen course please send an email to the organiser by 31st September. No payment required until EOD.

(introductory coaching available).


