Location & Parking	<p>From the A64 Malton to Scarborough road, turn south, 11 km east of Malton, at Grid Ref SE 896757 (link).</p> <p>Please Note: The A64 is a very fast road, competitors must take care when turning onto the track (at SE 896757) when arriving and on to the A64 when leaving the event. Car parking will be in Knapton Wood where available parking space is very limited. Competitors are requested to share transport if at all possible.</p>								
Terrain	<p>An area of mainly deciduous woodland on well drained chalk slopes with a variety of contour detail and good runnability.</p>								
Map	<p>1:7,500, 5m contours. Survey 2006, minor updates 2013, 2014. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.</p>								
Entries	<p>SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30.</p> <p>Online entries (strongly advised) through Fabian4 (www.fabian4.co.uk) – closing date midnight 25th March 2015. Postal entries on BOF entry form (last post mark 21st March), cheques to HALO – contact details on BOF website.</p> <p>Please Note: In the event that the numbers of entries may exceed the available parking space, online entry will close and postal entries will no longer be accepted. There will be no Entry on the Day for this event.</p>								
Courses	<p>Courses available (<i>class combinations for Middle Distance Championships</i>): Yellow (M10/W10), Orange (M12/W12), Light Green (M14/W14), Very Short Green (W70+), Short Green (M75+/W55,60,65), Green (M65,70/W16,45,50) Blue (M16,55,60/W35,40), Brown (M45, 50/W18,20,21), Black (M18,20,21,35,40).</p> <p>Unfortunately, it is not possible to provide a White or String Course at this event.</p> <p>Competitors may enter any course they wish. However, to qualify for the Middle Distance Championships they must enter the course for their age class indicated above.</p>
