Beverley Westwood Regional Event (level C)

(Sunday 8th December 2013)

- TRAVEL** Registration will be at Longcroft School, Burton Road, Beverley HU17 7EJ, Grid reference TA022406. Follow the A1174 (York Road) into Beverley. At North Bar traffic lights, turn left (north west) and follow Molescroft Road for approx. 1km. Burton Road is on the left just after a Pelican Crossing.
- REGISTRATION** 10:00 am to 12 noon.
Registration will be inside school buildings.
- STARTS** Starts and finishes will be approximately 800 metres from the school. This involves a walk on open grassland with one (busy) road crossing. Juniors should be accompanied.
10:30 to 12:30 Courses close at 2:30pm
- ENTRY FEES** Seniors £6.00 Juniors/Students £3.00

- COURSES** White to Blue

- TERRAIN** Beverley Westwood is a large area of predominately open common pastureland with three wooded areas, two of which are former quarried areas containing many contour features. The area is very popular with the public also contains an 18 hole golf course. Please do not cross the greens. Please give way to the golfers and their balls. The courses will be planned to allow runners to cross the fairways diagonally rather than at right angles. The White and Yellow courses will not be in the area of the golf course.
- MAP** 1:7,500 scale. 5m contours. A4 size.
Maps will be pre-marked on waterproof paper.
The line of the golf fairways are shown on the map with black arrows. The greens for each hole are permanently bounded by fences. Note that the tree lining the roads on the Westwood are not shown on the map.
- FACILITIES** There will be toilets at registration, but not at the start.
- OTHER ATTRACTIONS** It is the Beverley Festival of Christmas from 10am to 4pm
